City Manager Weik gave a brief report on the following activities in the City of San Saba: Downtown is crowded; Sip N Stroll; waiting on the Traffic count from TxDOT and anticipate to show an increase in traffic for the 2014 year; compliment the Businesses in town for the great job; Electric Department has taken down the Christmas decoration; next year there will be a Nativity scene in Mill Pond Park with several photo opportunities; the San Saba sign in Mill Pond Park will be permanently lit; Parks Department guys are excited on how the improve the Christmas lights in the park next year; no major problems last month; Water Department had a water break large water break before the Christmas Parade; Electric Department did not experienced any major problems last month however with the cold, wind, and rain however, there is a glitch in the power and every afternoon customers are reporting the lights flickering on the South end of town; the new Police Department is coming along, they are cleaning the floors and getting ready to stain; hopefully the new Police Department will be ready by the end of February; hopefully will be breaking sidewalks in one week in front of the Winery; the Golf Course has come to a screeching halt due to the weather; and the RV Park is full.
