

MINUTES
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
& BUDGET WORKSHOP
OF THE CITY OF SAN SABA
JUNE 27, 2023

The City Council of the City of San Saba, Texas convened into a budget workshop meeting on Tuesday, June 27, 2023 at approximately 6:00 p.m., in the City Hall Council Chambers located at 303 S. Clear Street.

Mayor Jordan called the budget workshop to order, announced a quorum was present and went directly into the Budget Workshop.

The budget workshop was conducted and presented the proposed budget requests for the 2023-2024 calendar year for the following departments: Eugene Bessent presented the budget for the Parks Department, (Expenses), Michael Whitley presented the budget for Golf (Expenses and Revenue), City Manager, Scott Edmonson presented the Rec. Center (Expenses), Municipal Court (Expenses), and Emergency Management (Expenses). No final decisions were made regarding budgets at this meeting.

City Manager, Scott Edmonson and Charlene Lindsay, City Treasurer met prior to the Budget Workshop and discussed the budgets and future needs for the departments.

The Budget Workshop adjourned at approximately 6:27 p.m. and went directly into Executive Session.

At 6:27 p.m., the City Council convened into Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.074, Texas Government Code, to evaluate the City Manager's Performance.


