

**Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)
MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The CITY OF SAN SABA water system PWS ID 2060001 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation Occurred in the monitoring period April 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017 (Second Quarter Report).

We are taking the following actions to address this issue: The violation has been corrected. The Second Quarter Report was submitted late which resulted as a violation. The City of San Saba is no longer in violation due to the Second Quarter Report being submitted and the Third Quarter Report being submitted on time.
