# SAN SABA CITY COUNCIL AGENDA REGULAR SESSION MONDAY, MARCH 20, 2023 (6:00) P.M.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING**

The City of San Saba will hold a public hearing at 6:00 PM on March 20, 2023, at City Hall, 303 S. Clear Street, San Saba, Texas, to receive comments from the Public regarding the following:

1) Michael and Amanda Brand are requesting the Planning & Zoning Commission and the San Saba City Council approve a Variance to the Existing Zoning requirements for Property located at 505 E. Church Street, legal description, the South 1/2 Block of 44 of Old Town San Saba, currently zoned One-Family Residential (R-2) to locate a Manufactured Home on said property. This is contingent on purchase of said property.
