The City of San Saba will hold a public hearing at 6:00 PM on July 13, 2021, at City Hall, 303 S. Clear Street, San Saba, Texas, to receive comments from the Public regarding the following:

Joseph (Billy) Sutton has asked the Planning & Zoning Commission and the San Saba City Council to approve a change in zoning for property, located in the Riverside Addition, Block Number 4, Lots 4, 5, 6, 11, and 12, and a 100'x20' portion of alleyway located between Lots 11 and 12, and Lots 5 and 6, from (I-1) Light Industrial to (R-2) One Family Residential.

The Planning and Zoning Commission met in Open Session on June 16, 2021 and voted 4 to 0 Vote in favor of approving this change in zoning. The City encourages citizens to make their views known at this public hearing.
