

**MINUTES

& BUDGET WORKSHOP
OF THE CITY COUNCIL

July 27, 2021**

The City Council of the City of San Saba, Texas convened into a Special Called meeting on Tuesday, July 27, 2021 at 6:00 p.m., in the City Hall Council Chambers located at 303 S. Clear Street.

CONSENT AGENDA ITEM:

The only item was to Approve Resolution No. 2021-29, a Resolution of the City of San Saba, Texas approving the Resignation of the Planning and Zoning Commission Member Nancy Van Etten and appointing Devon Hoyt to the Planning and Zoning Commission, term expiring January 2023. Mayor Pro-Tem Robert Whitten made a motion to Approve Resolution No. 2021-29, seconded by Alderman Oleta Behrens, and was unanimously approved.

As there was no further discussion, the meeting adjourned at 6:02 p.m. and immediately began the Budget Workshop. City Manager Scott Edmonson presented the 2021-2022 budget for General Admin, (Expenses), Health Services (Expenses), and Rec. Center (Expenses). (Expenses); Wastewater Plant (Expenses), and Wastewater Collection (Expenses).
