DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS:

The first item for discussion/action was to Discuss and consider approval of Resolution No. 2022-02 requesting to apply for a JAG Grant for a vehicle and equipment purchase through the Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division. RESOLUTION 2022-02

SAN SABA POLICE DEPARTMENT JAG GRANT VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT PURCHASE

WHEREAS, the San Saba City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of the City of San Saba, that the San Saba Police Department Vehicle and Equipment Purchase be operated for 1 year; and

WHEREAS, the San Saba City Council agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by Office of the Governor Criminal Justice Division/JAG grant application; and

WHEREAS, the San Saba City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the San Saba City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full;

WHEREAS, the San Saba City Council designates the City of San Saba Chief of Police as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the San Saba City Council approves submission of the grant application for the San Saba Police Department Vehicle and Equipment Purchase to the Office of the Governor.
