1) Ashleigh Broderick owner of Napoli's Italian Restaurant is requesting that the San Saba City Council approve a Variance to the Existing Alcohol Zoning requirements, Place of Business is within 300 ft. for a Church, Alcoholic Beverage Code 190.33 (a)1, for Property located at 210 E. Commerce Street, legal description Block 25, Old Town San Saba, N 1/3 (Commerce and Clear) currently zoned Commercial (C-2).
